a) Request for participation / Englemann Farm

St. Clair County Chairman Mark Kern described that they are trying to acquire a piece of real estate referred to as the Englemann Farm. This property is near the Shiloh border and is approximately 150 acres and would make for a great recreational space. The property is significant because it is the home of Frederick Englemann who was a co-founder of the Missouri Botanical Gardens, and many of the same plants that are planted in the botanical garden are also planted on this piece of property. In addition this property is where the first Christmas tree in the Mississippi Valley was decorated. At the highest point of the property you can see all the way to the St. Louis Arch and the court house and you can also see the other Englemann Farm located in Mascoutah. They want to tie this property into a bike trail near SWIC and then to O'Fallon. The Englemann cemetery is still located there and still active. Plans for the \$4.6 million dollar purchase price include \$1 million from St. Clair County, \$600,000 from the Regional County Park and Recreation group and \$400,000 from MEPRD for a three year period, also OSLAD seeking three rounds of \$750,000. It has not been determined who will be used to acquire the land. Director Peters asked how close it was to a connection to the metro link trail, and was told about a mile. St.Clair County Chairman Mark Kern explained that this is a great piece of property; it is surrounded by subdivisions which would make a great park for the County.

Director Kane made a motion, seconded by Director Evans to indicate a positive intent for MEPRD to participate in the funding of the acquisition for the Englemann Farm consistent with the request for the \$400,000.00 per year for three years.
