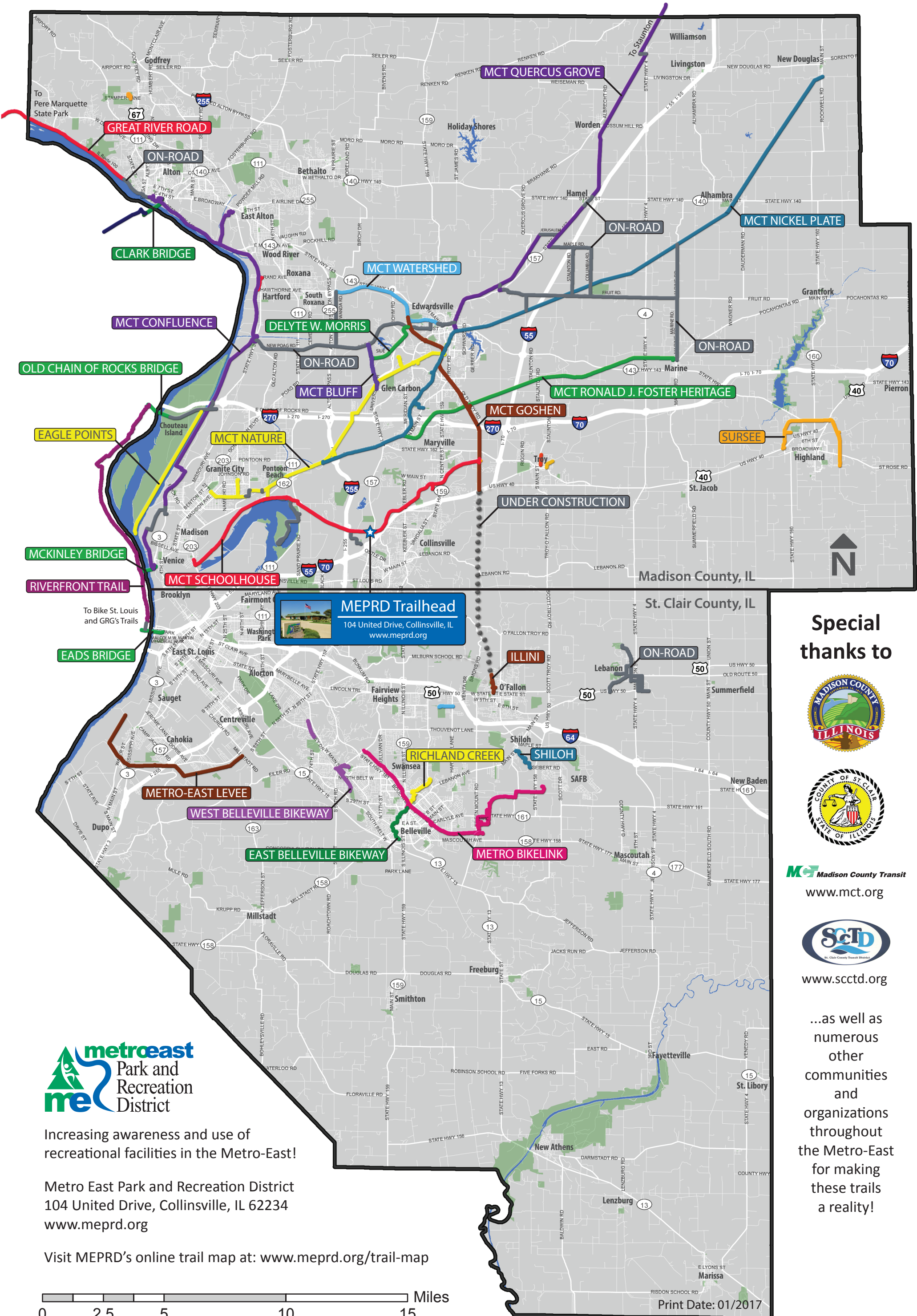
There are currently 151 miles of shared-use paths in Madison County, IL and 29 miles in St. Clair County, IL. See trail map on reverse side.
